### **Summary of the Study**

This study highlights the most important features learned from the lives of young companions who were raised of a certain prophecy, namely, a researcher has to answer a key question:

What are the features learned from the educational lives of young companions?

### The branches of this question the following sub-questions:

- what are the features learned from the educational life befriend companions who were the Prophet peace be upon him or in part from the seventh to the tenth?
- what are the features learned from the educational life Sahaabiyaat who had befriend the Prophet peace be upon him or in part from the seventh to the tenth?

Through the study, the researcher found the results highlight the interest of the Prophet peace be upon him children in general and especially Balsahabp Perhaps the most important results:

## 1. In the Worship Side:

- child's education, worship of prayer and fasting.
- disciplining children to love the Prophet peace be upon him and the truth of his Prophethood and love for each home and reading the Koran.
- instil a spirit of humility and the fear of God and piety, and worship Allah, Lord of the worlds in them .
- familiarize them with Halal and Haram as well as children's education and preservation of the legitimate supplications chatter.
- bring obligatory duties urged by the Prophet peace be upon him at the coming of the child and the appropriate choice of name.
- familiarize the child patient in affliction and the power of faith in God Almighty.
- The creation of the girl and young people to matters of marriage to choose a husband or wife.

## 2. In the Moral Side:

• child's education, behavioral and moral virtues are the fruit of the fruits of the conviction and the proper religious upbringing of the child rearing to truthfulness, honesty and integrity, altruism and respect for the large and ATD Generous, charity and love for others, because of the Trfhm Aldnaya and good for dealing with others .

- child-rearing to renounce Bad behavior such as lying and arrogance, estrangement, because it insults Islam's consideration of ugly.
- child-rearing on giving and giving and spending and makrooh miserly love of money.
- child-rearing of politeness and good manners with scientists .
- child-rearing literature with parents or others.
- Strengthen self-confidence, and promote the positive side, when compliance with the creation of good .
- The importance of justice between the children .
- Dealing with children, whether their answer their questions and numerous, or erroneous behavior of the child.

## 3. In the physical side:

- child-rearing to the Rules of healthy sleep and how to remove the harm and personal hygiene and to accustom the child to exercise and play sports .
- accustom the child to austerity and lack of dumping in the enjoyment and jihad for the sake of God.
- raise the child on the lives of seriously and manhood away from complacency and parents.
- endure hardship and adversity in an education, as obtained from Ibn Abbas.

# 4. In the mental and scientific:

- the responsibility of parents in education and focus their minds on understanding intake and abstract knowledge and understanding adult.
- Focus on the education of children reading the Koran and the Prophet's biography and all they need of forensic science.
- the child's education is to be learned such as prayer, fasting and almsgiving, mortgage, power of attorney from a young age.
- give children some responsibility, such as sponsors to lead the prayers when the villages were stored more than others .
- teach children good behavior in problem situations and choose appropriate action to Islam .
- novel small sayings of the Prophet peace be upon him and the acceptance of Muslims are evidence of the child's ability on the conservation and understanding and perception and the question of science.

## 5. In the psychological Side:

- child-rearing from an early age, the boldness and frankness, courage and confidence and love of others.
- giving the child the freedom to act and take responsibility and exercise matters as they grow.
- instill courage, and not scare them and get them used to the self-confidence.
- satisfy the need for emotional and achieve the principle of love and compassion and caressing, kissing.
- Play with children and to bring happiness to their hearts.
- Choose good names for the child and change his name if it has no meaning because of its good effect in the same child.
- Use the method of abandonment and dimension to discipline the child when wrong to regret what he has made by the behavior.
